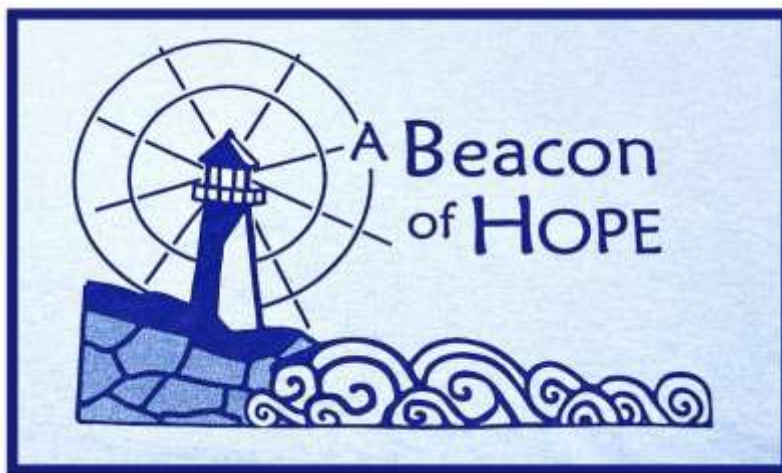
*Churchyard Work Party, April 23rd, 9:00 AM*
