As this month draws to end, Barry Turley has stepped down from his position as Music Director and Organist. Barry came to All Saints' in 2005 bringing his immense musical gifts, deep experience as a church organist, and his wonderfully quick and keen sense of humor.

We have been blessed with Barry's musical ministry over these many years and his meticulous care of our historic organ. Memorable performances in earlier years include the combined All Saints' and St. Martin's choir singing of Gabriel Fauré's *Requiem* and the All Saints' choir singing Daniel Pinkham's (one of Barry's many musical colleagues and friends) *Christmas Cantata* one Christmas.

A fantastic organist, Barry played so many soul-stirring preludes and postludes for us. His stirring performance of Widor's *Toccata in F Movement Five* (Easter 2020) and compositions by J.S. Bach are particularly memorable to me.

Barry has been especially attentive to the needs and wishes of families of parishioners who have died, providing musical offerings that have evoked both comfort and joy.

Thank you, Barry for sharing your musical gifts with us.

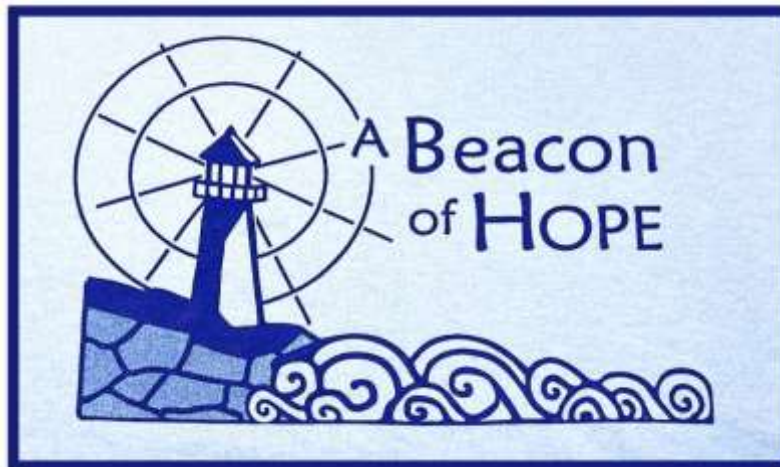
