



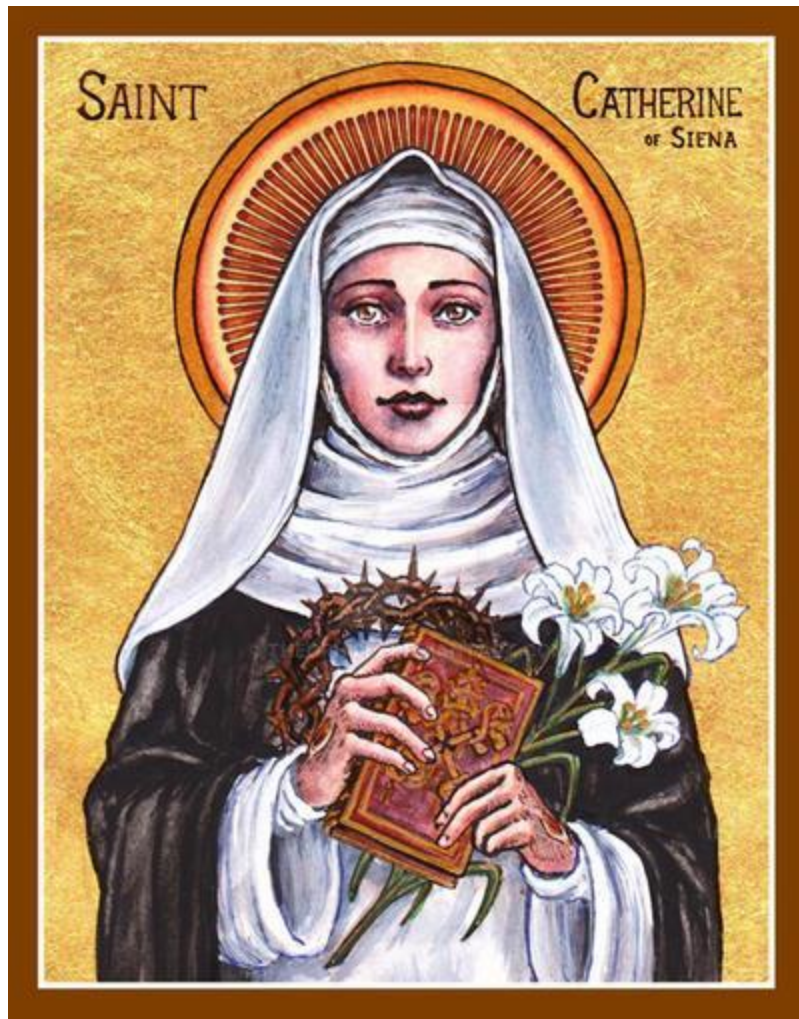

Dear All Saints' Family,

Catherine of Siena, the saint that we commemorate today, heard the voice of Christ at the age of six and insisted on following that voice even at a very young age. Thus followed a remarkable life of contemplation, prayer, writing, and activism.

The second youngest of 25 children, Catherine had an extraordinary and lasting impact in her short life. She was born in 1347, the same year that a devastating epidemic hit Europe, the “black death” where about a third of the European population died. She joined the Third Order of Dominicans at sixteen and became a nurse who was known to care for patients with leprosy and cancer.

Over time Catherine’s reputation as a spiritual adviser grew. People from all walks of life sought out Catherine for spiritual wisdom—peasants, priests, monarchs, and popes. She took to writing letters to leaders around Europe. Close to 400 of those letters survived over the centuries and can be read today. A contemplative and mystic of holy courage who did not hesitate to speak her faith to secular and church powers, Catherine died at the age of 32, in 1380.

Almighty and everlasting God, who kindled the flame of thy love in the heart of your servant Catherine of Siena: Grant unto us the same strength of conviction and power of love that, as we rejoice in her triumph, we may profit by her example; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
