

Sunday's postlude features a fugue from the *Eight Little Preludes and Fugues*, long attributed to Johann Sebastian Bach, and is the companion to last week's postlude. Recent Bach scholarship in the last few decades has questioned the attribution to JSB, however, and they are now believed to be the works of a Bach contemporary, perhaps one of his pupils, though the definitive composer is yet unknown. Nevertheless, they are elegant and concise compositions which explore a variety of styles and performing problems, and thus still constitute excellent examples and exercises for those learning to play the organ. And perhaps you will agree that they are worthy to hear as well!


