Dear All Saints' Family,

At our recent session of Episcopal 102, we spent time with the *Book of Common Prayer* otherwise known as the Prayer Book or the BCP. We uncovered sections that were quite new to some of our group. We looked at Morning and Evening Prayer, discussed differences between Rite 1 and Rite 11, talked about rubrics and collects, and took a look at the forms for the Prayers of the People.

The Prayer Book is a gem that is worth exploring. You are sure to find a prayer or wisdom that that you have not encountered before. If you are

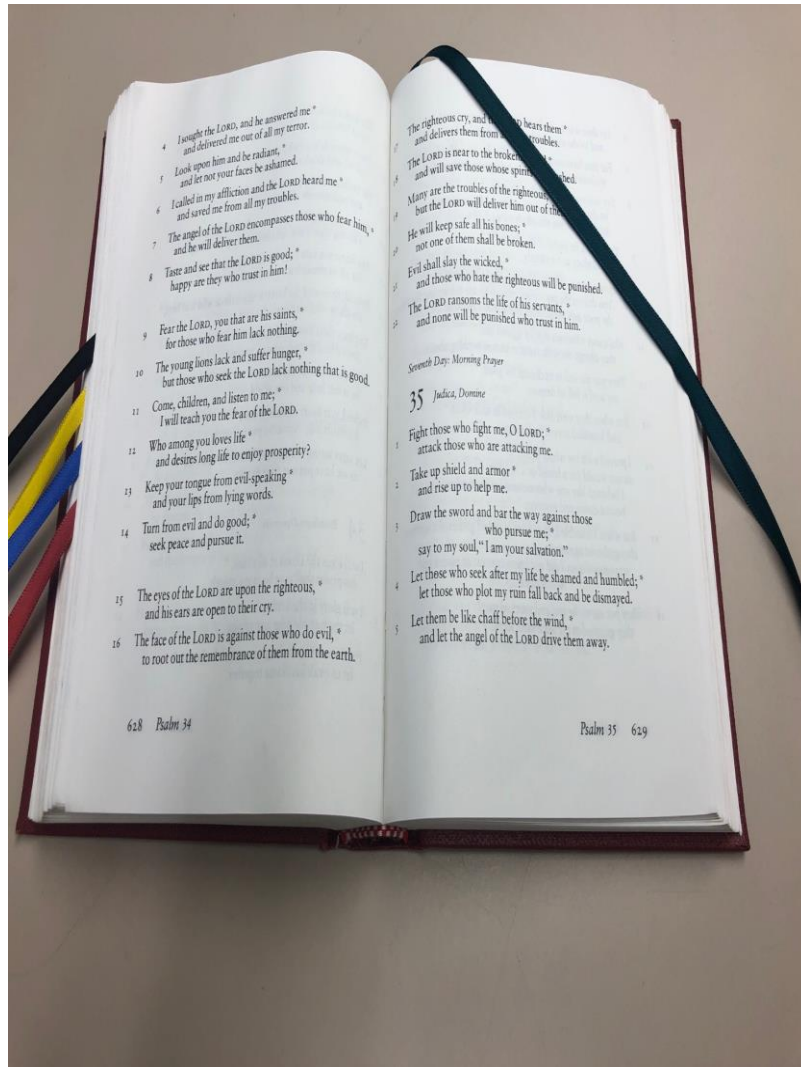
participating in services at home via Zoom and would like to borrow a Prayer Book, please let me know. I am happy to arrange a drop off.

You may have noticed that our service programs are a little slimmer these days. We include the scripture readings for each week but refer to page numbers in the BCP and *Hymnal* for the rest of the liturgy. We try to limit our use of paper wherever possible.

This gets me to the topic of liturgical ribbons. I find them indispensable as I move back and forth in the BCP during the service. We move from the Holy Eucharist Rite that begins with the Word of God (p.355 in the BCP) to the Psalter, followed by several more moves around the Prayer Book as the service continues.

You may find liturgical ribbons helpful too. Deirdre Greelish has generously donated some ribbon sets to the parish for those who wish to use them for worship. Given our propensity to sit in the same pews each week, you may leave the ribbon set in the Prayer Book for your use the following week.

Below is an example of how you might use the liturgical ribbons. I placed a set of ribbons in one of our Prayer Books and marked the Psalm appointed for this Sunday (Psalm 34:1-8) with the green ribbon.



Help yourself to a set of ribbons as you enter the church if you wish to try it out. Thank you, Deirdre for this thoughtful gift.

All are welcome to join our Sunday in-person service of Holy Eucharist at 9:30 am followed by coffee hour outside in the courtyard.

Please wear a mask and practice social distancing if you are not yet fully vaccinated.

Like many organizations we are discussing whether it is time to move back to masks for all inside the church as a safety precaution related to the Delta variant. I am participating in a Clergy Town Hall with Bishop Knisely this afternoon to discuss appropriate church response to the current situation in RI. I will keep you posted.
