Dear All Saints' Family,

This is the season we celebrate and mark a series of “epiphanies” or occasions when Jesus is recognized as the Messiah by different groups of people. We celebrated the Feast of Epiphany on January 6<sup>th</sup>. We marked another epiphany last Sunday in the Baptism of the Lord. This Sunday we will reflect on a third “epiphany” at the wedding feast in Cana when Jesus turns water into wine.

Our prayer around this time of year reflects the revelation of God’s great light in Jesus. Like this Sunday’s collect: *Almighty God, whose Son our Savior Jesus Christ is the light of the world: Grant that your people, illumined by your Word and Sacraments, may shine with the radiance of Christ's glory, that he may be known, worshipped, and obeyed to the ends of the earth; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who with you and the Holy Spirit lives and reigns, one God, now and for ever.*

Where are you seeing the light of Christ this week?

May the blessing of light be on you,  
light without and light within.

May the blessed sunlight shine upon you  
and warm your heart  
til it glows like a great fire

and strangers may warm themselves  
as well as friends.

And may the light  
shine from your eyes,  
like a candle set in
