If the city of Providence declares a parking ban or the State of RI declares a weather emergency urging people to stay off the roads, our

If the Sunday Service is canceled this weekend, the Annual Meeting will be held the following Sunday, February 8.

If the city of Providence has not declared a parking ban, please use your discretion when deciding whether or not to come to church on Sunday morning. We do not want you to put yourself in danger by driving on icy or snowy roads or walking on snow-covered surfaces.

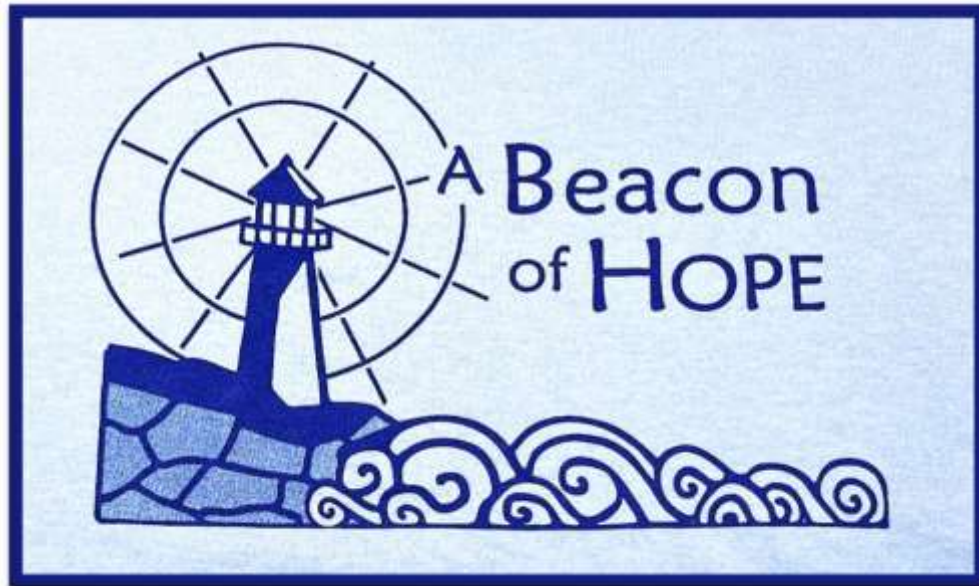


Notes from the Music Program

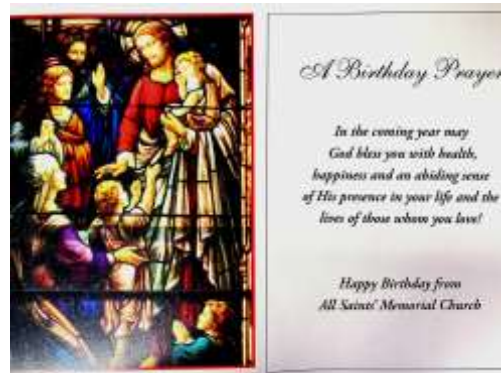
