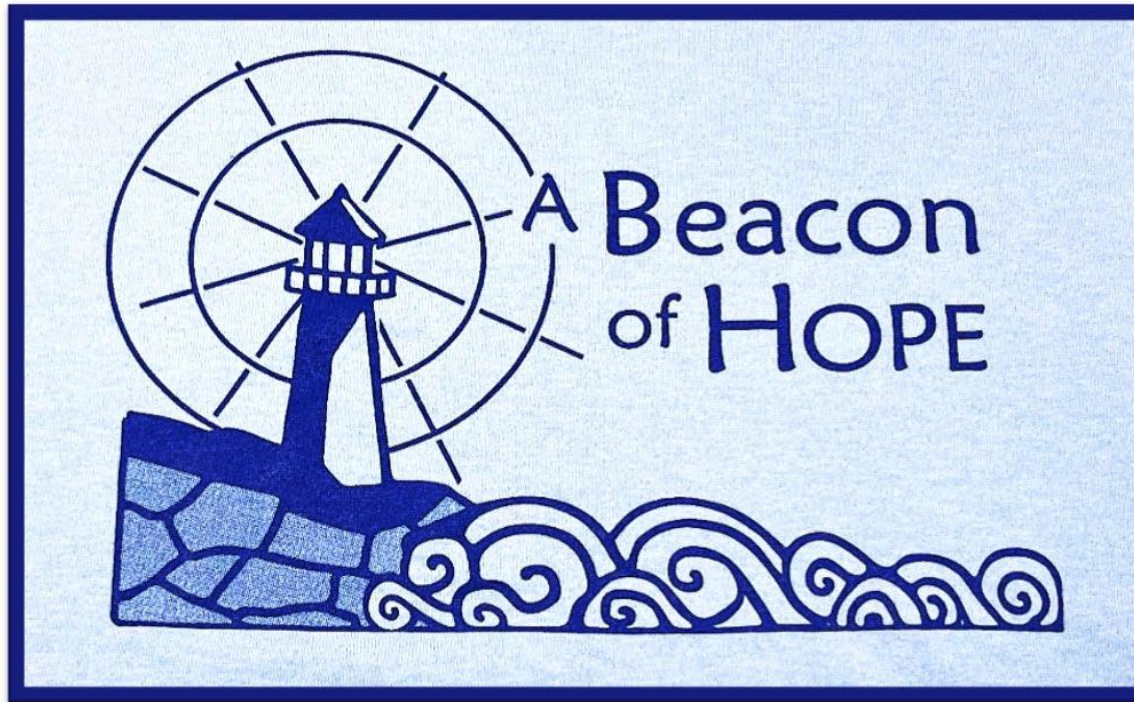

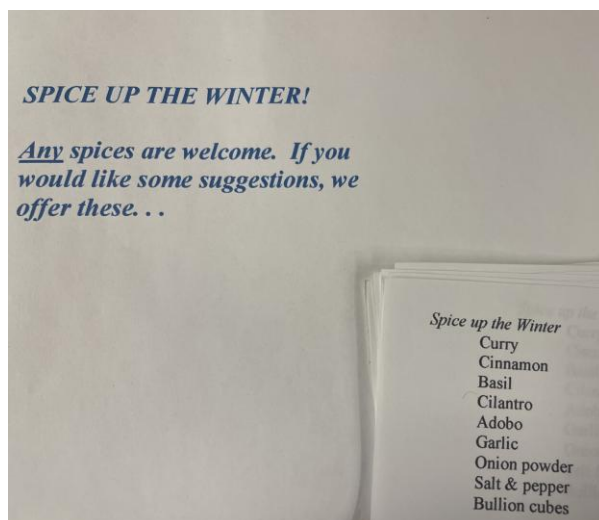


Outreach Ministry
