Notes from the Organ Bench

The choir of ASMC invites adult singers and older youth to join us in singing the praises of God. Rehearsals are Wednesday evening from 7 to 8:30 in the Choir Room. Sunday morning we meet to warm up and rehearse from 8:30 to 9:15 before the regular service at 9:30.

No audition is necessary.

Choir will begin after Labor Day. This year Labor Day is Monday the 6th of September. The first Rehearsal will be Wednesday, the 8th of September, and our first Sunday will be the 12th of September.

Anyone who would like to practice is invited to join a session at the church on Wednesday evening July 28th, from 7:00-7:45. Another practice session is scheduled for August 25th.

A few good reasons to join the choir:

- The choir is an easy way to make lots of new friends and feel a part of the group
- The choir provides a healthy cultural and creatively artistic balance in these days of heavily databased education and societal norms.
- Choir is therapeutic; rehearsals become a time when singers can put aside, for a while at least, the other pressures and concerns of the day.
- Choir develops poise under pressure.
- Choir teaches the value of teamwork.
- Choir provides the foundation for a lifetime of enjoyment in music.
- Choir serves as a ministry by adding beauty and aesthetic depth to worship.

- Choir provides an anchor for regular church participation in a time when secular attractions and pressures pull many away from church participation.
- Finally, the end product of the choir is music, and I have always been moved by the words of American composer John Cage, which give us a framework within which to sing and play: *"Music is important, because, from time to time, it allows us to be touched by the infinite."*
