

Thanks to our dedicated Music Director Search Committee we now have a vision statement for the All Saints' Music Program. This vision will guide our next Music Director/Organist:

Vision Statement

Music that brings all closer to Christ is the ultimate goal of the Music Program at All Saints'. We will achieve this by developing a quality program geared to sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ through song that includes music from throughout the Anglican communion, past and present. Our program must recognize and embrace the diversity and the range of traditions within our congregation. Music at All Saints' must support and develop congregational singing as well as build and improve the choir.


