This Saturday we are participating in the West Broadway Neighborhood Association (WBNA) Annual Yard Sale. 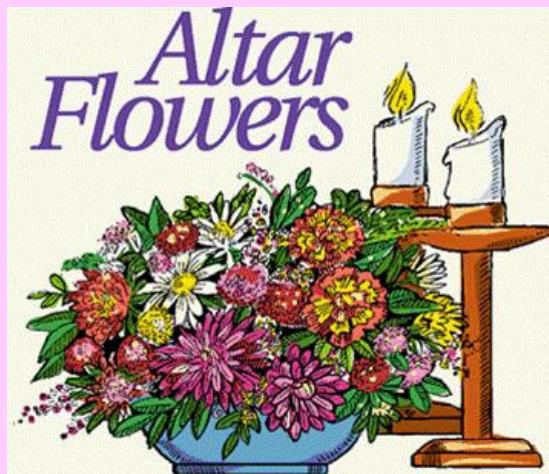
