## *Notes from the Organ Bench*

Like the proverbial high school hockey player who, in his 40s, decides to get back on ice to a disastrous outcome, singers also have to work very carefully to bring their vocal muscles and reactions back into shape.

The vast “summer break” we have been given by the COVID pandemic means that we cannot just throw ourselves into the fall season like we did in Septembers past. This year I want to begin slowly and carefully, with

some vocal technique work before the return to our regular schedule.

I am proposing that we hold two workshops:

- 1 in mid-July
- 1 in mid-August

The sessions will last 45 minutes, and will consist of a careful review of vocal techniques, basics, and warm-ups.

The sessions will take place either outside or in the church.

There is also the option of private voice coaching with David Moniz.

At all costs, I want to avoid what happened to one of my singers at Trinity Episcopal, Stoughton. Her work schedule kept her out of the choir for several years, until a generous whim brought her up to the choir gallery on Christmas Eve, volunteering to join us for Handel's *Hallelujah Chorus*, a piece she knew well. What she had forgotten was that it's long, and the soprano part is very high. The unfortunate outcome was an injury to the muscles in her throat that needed long and expensive medical care.

Finally—thanks be to God—the regular choir season will start, as always, with choir practice on the Wednesday after Labor Day. This year, that will be September 8, at 7 p.m.

I cannot express how much I look forward to seeing all of you again. Let's see if we can bring a little bit of the All Saints' Memorial musical tradition as our contribution to the return to "normalcy" which we all need and want.
