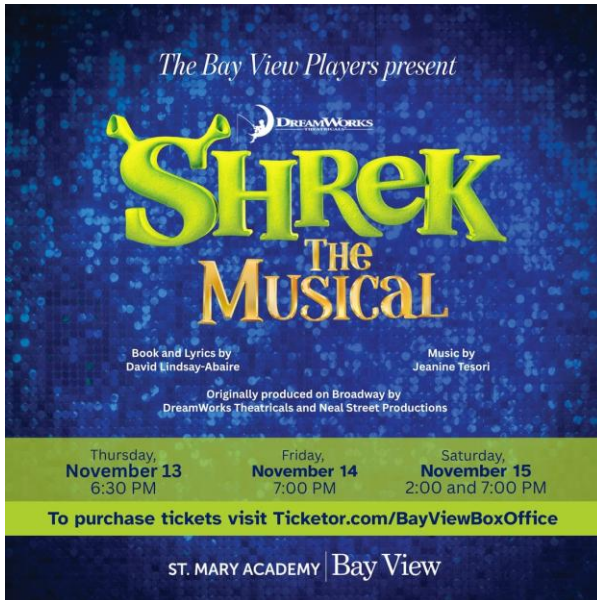
Dear All Saints' Family,

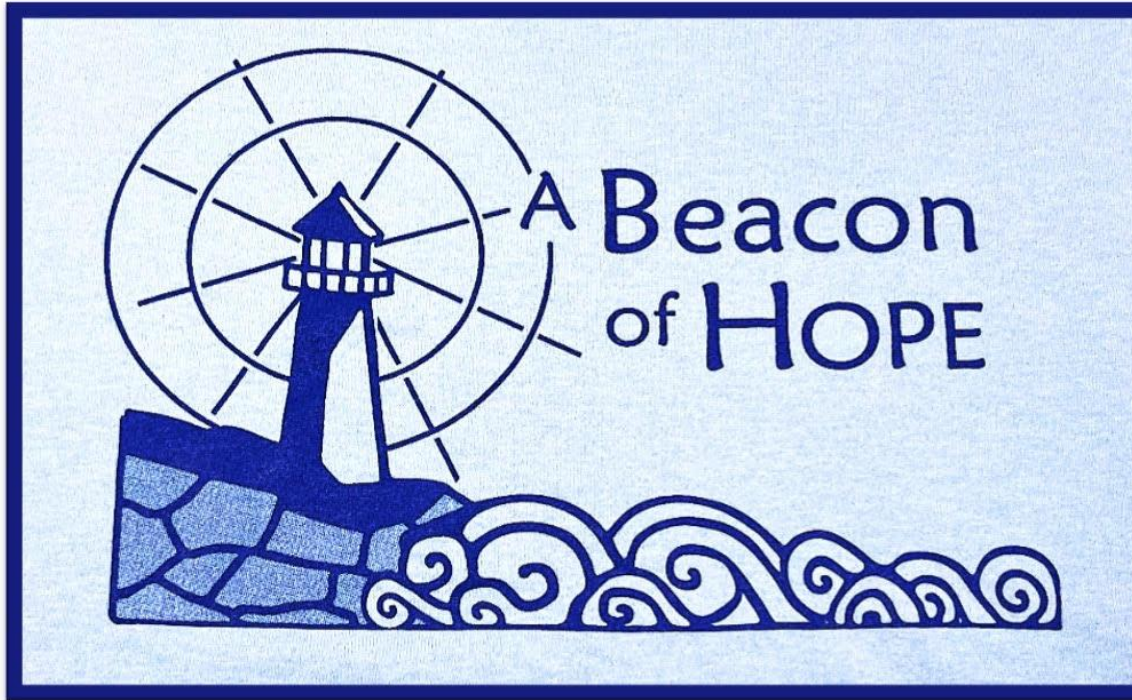

The deadline for requesting a basket has passed.

Sunday November 16

For example, 62 cans of carrots are needed. You may want to purchase 20 cans of carrots. Write your name on the sheet next to "Can carrots" and include the number of cans you will provide. If you wish to be reimbursed for the food items please give the receipt to Linda or Pattie. Sign-

up to donate food items is this Sunday, November 9 and the following Sunday, November 16.

Food items must be brought to the church by 9:00am Saturday morning, November 22. (You may bring non-perishable food items the previous Sunday or earlier).

Saturday November 22: Outreach assembles and organizes Thanksgiving Boxes.

Sunday November 23: Distribution of boxes to recipients and the Lutheran congregation.
