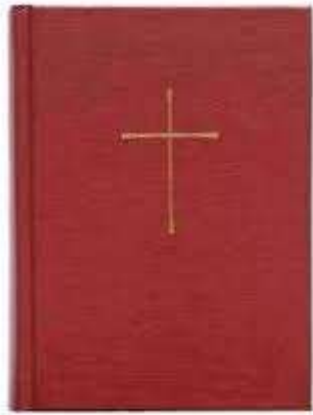

Dear All Saints' Family,

The *Book of Common Prayer* is a treasure. At first, it can be a bit complicated to follow the flow of a service especially for those who are new to the Episcopal tradition. After a while, the flipping back and forth between pages becomes easier and the logic and depth of the beloved Prayer Book unfolds along with the beauty and variety of prayers.

Did you know that the Prayer Book has a section towards the end of the book called *Prayers and Thanksgivings*? *Thanksgivings* begin on p. 836 with two versions of a *General Thanksgiving*. Next you will find a *Litany of Thanksgiving* that you may want to pray on Thanksgiving day. If so, know that others will be praying with you. Then comes *Thanksgivings for the Church and National Life*. You will recognize the short prayer for

Heroic Service that I included in last week's messenger for Veteran's Day. Thanksgiving prayers continue with gratitude for *Harvest*, the *Beauty of the Earth*, and *Family and Personal Life*.

I encourage you to take a look at these prayers perhaps on Sunday when you have a BCP in hand. Take a few minutes each day this week for gratitude. The Prayer Book will help you find the words. Ernest George Hirsch, age 93, of the Village at Willow Crossing in Mansfield, former longtime resident of Foxborough and Westport, passed away peacefully on Sunday, October 30, 2022, surrounded by his loving family. He was predeceased by his beloved wife of 61 years, Carolyn (Norgren) Hirsch.

Ernest was born in Providence, RI on November 7, 1928, the son of the late George O. and Irma P. (Mende) Hirsch. He was a graduate of Classical High School in Providence and earned his mechanical engineering degree at the University of Rhode Island where he played football. He proudly served his country during the Korean War in the United State Army and was a member of the Army National Guard for over 25 years. He and his wife Carolyn were married on September 7, 1957 at the Gloria Dei Lutheran Church in Providence, RI.

Ernest was a mechanical engineer for New England Electric in Westborough, C.E. Maguire in Foxborough and Parsons-Main in Boston.

He was a member of All Saints Memorial Church in Providence, RI. He was a former Town Fence Viewer, Chairman of the Town Water and Sewer Committee and member of the Homart Mall Committee for the Town of Foxborough. A history buff, he was a member of the Massachusetts Archeology Society, the Foxborough and Westport Historical Society and was a history lecturer at the Villages at Willow Crossing. He enjoyed spending time at his home in Westport and was a member of the Westport Yacht Club. He was an avid reader and New England Patriots fan.

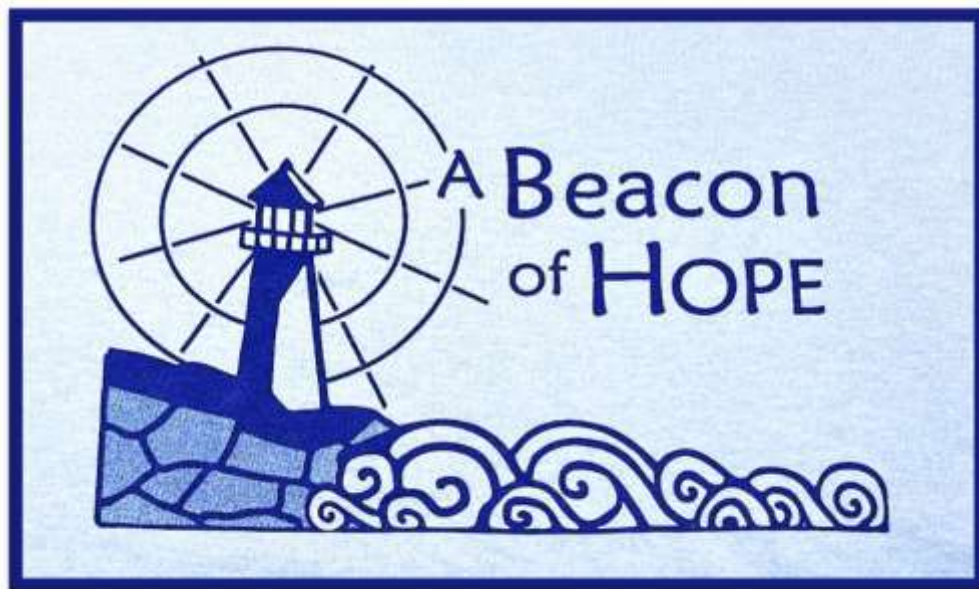
