Dear All Saints' Family,

This Sunday we celebrate Christ the King Sunday. It is the last Sunday of the church calendar. The season of Advent begins soon.

In the celebration of Christ the King we remember Christ's Kingship and the Kingdom of God, and what that means for us today. It is a chance to ponder Christ the Lord and what makes God's way different from other kinds of Kingship – a Kingdom ethic that has its source, and breath, and light, and life, in Christ.

I find the above photo of migrants moving through southern Mexico, the cross held high, a glimpse and a declaration of Christ the King. Christ walking with the vulnerable and displaced, powerfully present to those in

need.

In Sunday's Gospel, Pilate asks Jesus, "So you are a king?" Jesus answers Pilate by talking about truth and the Kingdom. This Kingdom is quite different from Pilate's political world. This Kingdom is not a physical space. It is a community where life begins and ends in God, in the way of Jesus.

The kingdom is here, because of the Incarnation, because the risen Lord is among us. And we live in hope of a future, eternal Kingdom, where love and peace reign, where justice and mercy kiss, where the blind see, where the deaf hear, and where the lame get up and walk.

The celebration of Christ the King reminds us that each of us is held and remembered by Christ in whom all things are held together. In Christ, we are transformed and empowered to carry on that same Kingdom ministry to one another.


*Help Us to Fully Fund our Broadcasting Ministry*



Throughout the pandemic we have all benefited from Ryan Mott's ministry as our AV "go to" tech guy. In addition to keeping us connected, he has built a system that allows anyone to join our services "live" or watch them at another time via Facebook. To date, generous donations of \$7,000 and a Diocesan grant of \$2,050 have funded the purchase of a camera, microphone, and other equipment. We need an additional \$2000 to purchase the remaining equipment and complete the necessary

### *Clerestory??*



Until a few years ago, I had no idea how to pronounce this word (KLEER-stor-ee), let alone what it meant. Our clerestory windows are the stained glass windows way up near the ceiling that provide additional light in the church. Although not meant to provide ventilation, some of ours have been, due to rotting frames or broken glass. Our project to repair the six (three on each side) above the altar got side-tracked by the pandemic, but as of last week, is now half complete and paid for (in part by a grant from the Champlin Foundation and in part by funds from the Henshaw Trust).

Because they are so high, they are hard to see. From our parking lot, you can see the repaired and reinstalled ones from outside; from the altar, they are the highest windows on the east side (to your left as you face the altar). The ones on the right will be taken out, repaired, reframed, and covered with protective casements next spring. – Becky –
