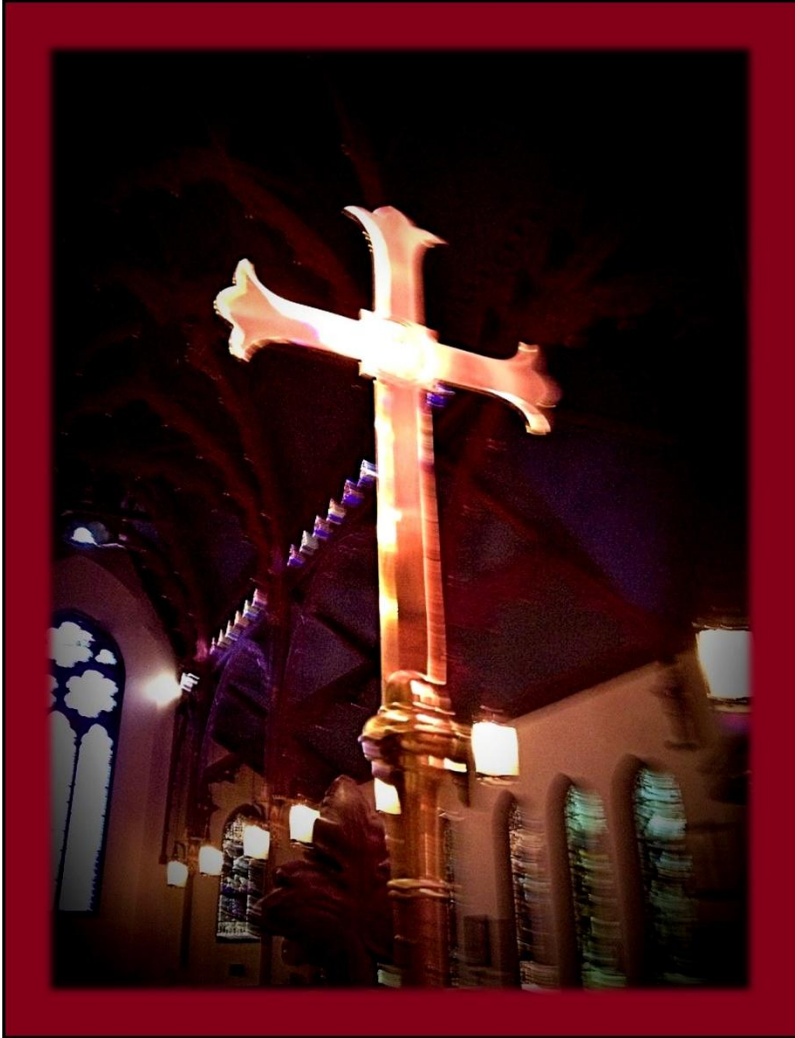

Waiting in Hope

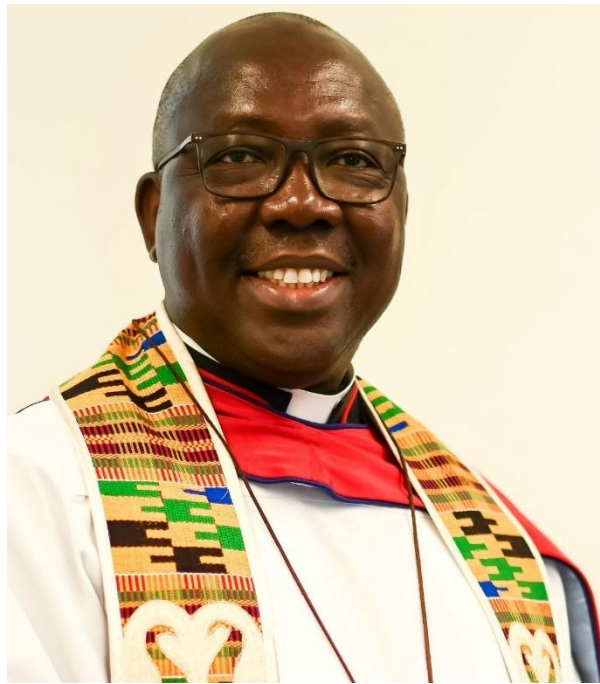

Prayer For Peace (BCP p. 258)

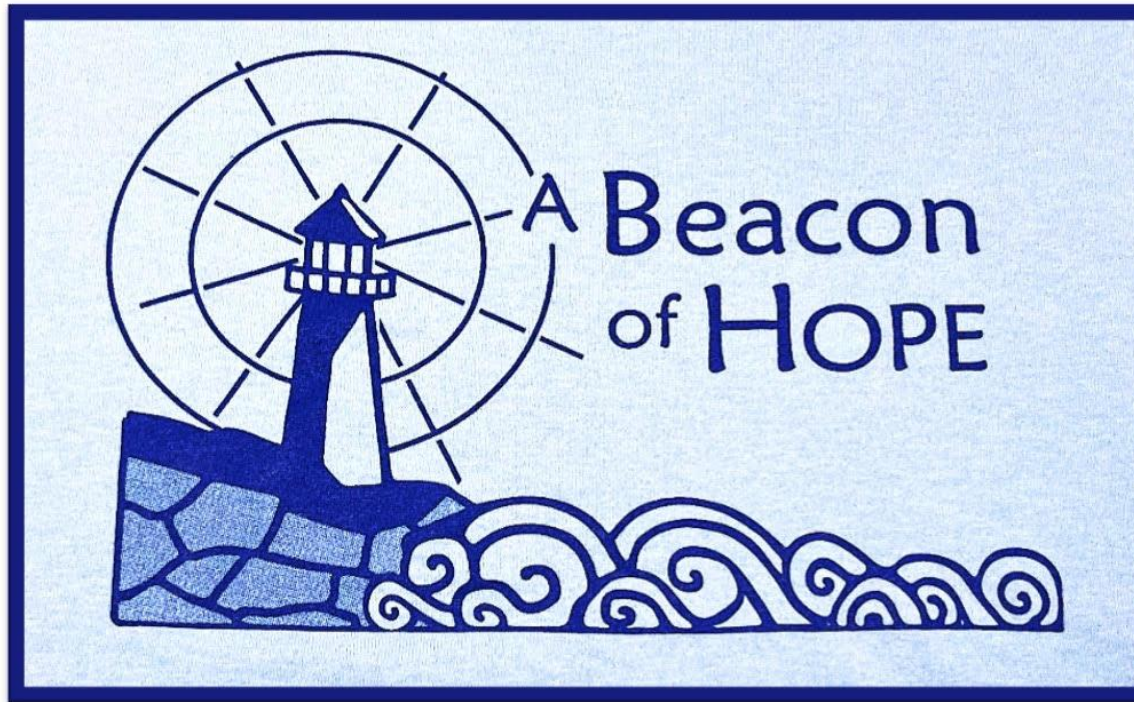
