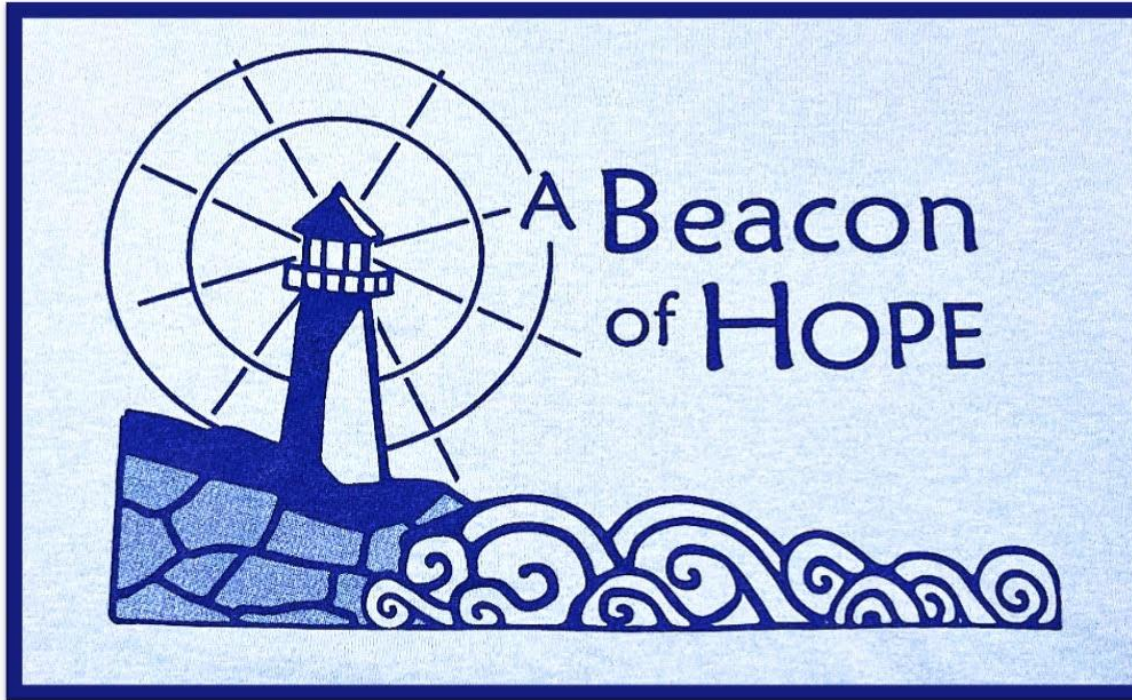

Thanksgiving Basket Schedule, 2025

The deadline for requesting a basket has passed.

Sunday November 9 and November 16

Pattie. Sign-up to donate food items is this Sunday, November 9 and the following Sunday, November 16.

Food items must be brought to the church by 9:00am Saturday morning, November 22. (You may bring non-perishable food items the previous Sunday or earlier).

Sunday November 23: Distribution of boxes to recipients and the Lutheran congregation.
