CENTENNIAL REMEMBRANCE OF THE END OF WORLD WAR I

On November 11, 1918 at 11:00 a.m. the armistice which ended World War I was signed. A plaque honoring the people from All Saints' Memorial Church who served in World War I is located next to the door to the Sacristy. The list of names includes six people who died in service to their country: Walter A. Bennett, William Brailsford, Frederick C. Cooper, Edgar H. Greenhalge, Charles B. Lincoln, Jr. and Ronald Simmons. It is appropriate for us to observe the centennial of the signing of the armistice and honor the people who served - especially the six people who died.
