Dear All Saints' Family,

Come and Worship! Rejoice in Fellowship! Love and Serve the Lord. You may have seen these welcoming and joyful words so many times that you hardly notice them. You see them as the heading of this newsletter each week. We are sent out at the end of our worship with the words, "Let us go in peace to love and serve the Lord."

This Sunday we will rejoice together as we welcome Bishop Knisely and witness the Confirmation of Natalya, Anne Marie, and Derrick. Bishop Knisely will preside at our 9:30 am Service of Holy Eucharist with Confirmation. The fellowship will continue after the Service with a

reception outside in the courtyard.

On Sunday at 5:00 PM we invite you back to the church for the James F. Burgess, Jr. Memorial Concert. The Rhode Island College Choral Program is returning to All Saints' to sing their fall concert in memory of Jim. Their lively concert will feature a range of styles, cultures, and eras. As you can imagine, the last 1 1/2 years have been challenging for the singers. The students have been working hard and we have a plan for a safe and enjoyable hour of music. The choirs will be masked and we ask that the audience be as well. The concert is free and all are welcome.

Saturday morning offers another opportunity to love and serve the Lord, with the Trinity Square Clean-up. Trinity Square Together invites us to join a morning of planting trees, building tree guards, raking leaves, and picking up trash around the intersection of Broad St. and Elmwood Ave. If you would like to help, come to at All Saints' at 9:00 this Saturday and we can go to Trinity Square together. Or, meet at the Salvation Army in Trinity Square. Participants are asked to wear a mask and bring gloves and a gardening tool if you wish.

Wear your All Saints' T-shirt if you have one. We have a few more at the church if you would like one.



A reminder: Please wear a mask and practice social distancing during our services if you are not yet fully vaccinated. We ask that you refrain from singing if you are not yet fully vaccinated. As an additional safety precaution, we ask everyone to remain in the pews for the Peace.
