On Sunday, Oct 21 at 5:00 PM in Worcester, the Presiding Bishop will be giving a revival with a similar theme - Rekindling Hope, Sharing Light and Loving Jesus.

Bishop Curry's Revival webpage describes it as a mix of worship, teaching, faith-sharing, prayer, and engagement with God's mission for the sake of spiritual renewal and transformation of people and communities. 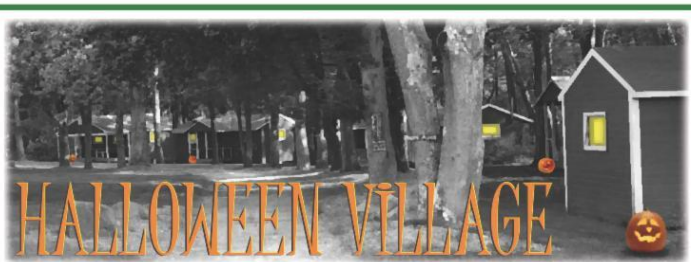

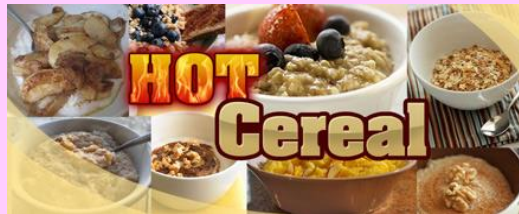
KNITTING, CROCHETING
