*James F. Burgess, Jr. Memorial Choral Concert*

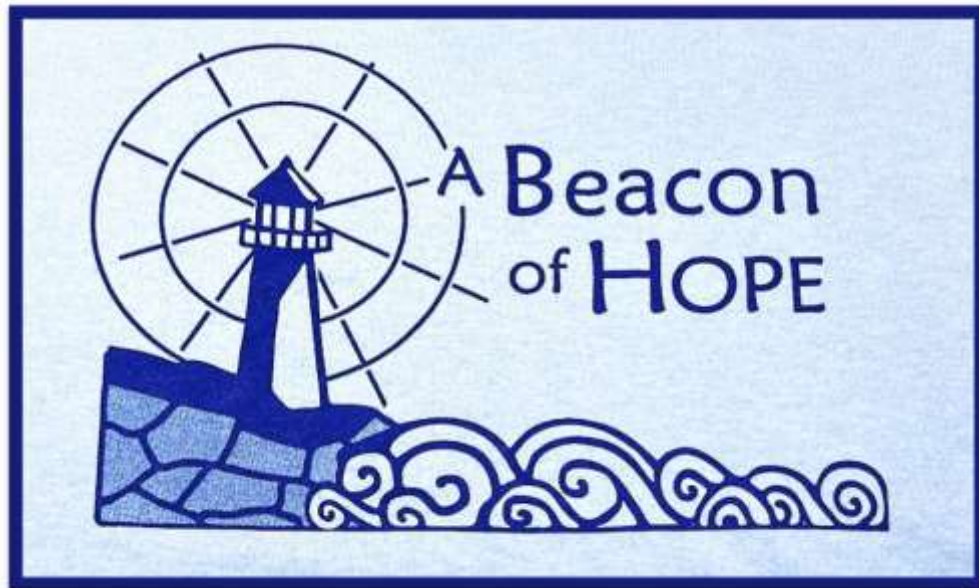
*October 16th, 5:00 pm at All Saints'*

## *Update: “Healing of Creation” Garden*

Not all planting days are sunny, but plants can get settled nicely in the rain, as when we experienced the remnants of Hurricane Ian on Saturday. We planted goldenrods, swamp milkweed, New England aster, ox eye daisy, and New York ironweed, among others, and a small herb garden. These are along the south side of the church where Ground Work RI removed several bushes earlier in the week. In the spring we will add a small vegetable garden and additional plants as needed.



The recent rains have helped the wildflower seeds in the west side window wells to germinate. We will look for them and many of our other plants to begin blooming in the spring.
