### *Music Notes*

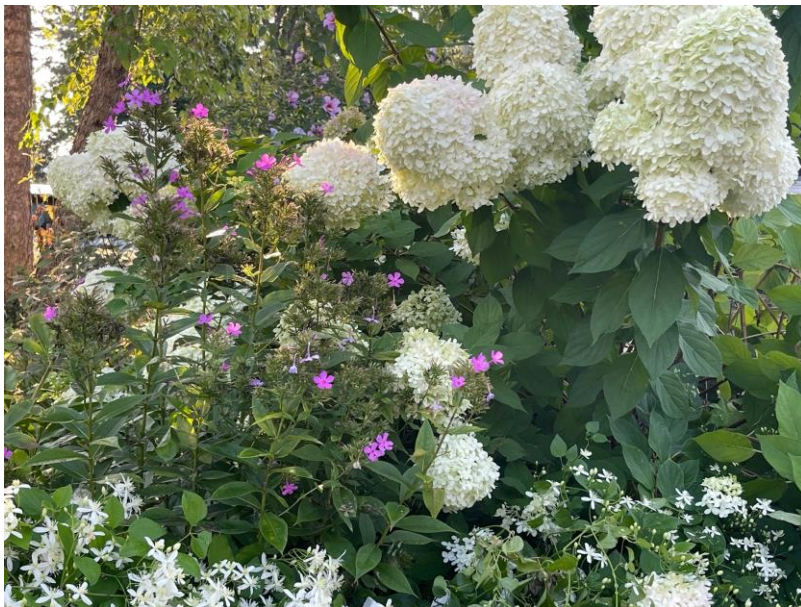


Our mix of music on Sunday includes two hymns by famed turn-of-the-century English composer Ralph Vaughan Williams (1872-1958), framing the service at beginning and end (Processional and Recessional), as well as his arrangement of an English melody for our choral anthem (you can follow the text relevant to our readings at Hymn #591). During communion, however, in contrast we feature hymns by two well-known 19th- and 20th-century gospel composers, Charles Hutchinson Gabriel (1856-1932) and Andrae Crouch (1942-2015). Gabriel's father, in fact,

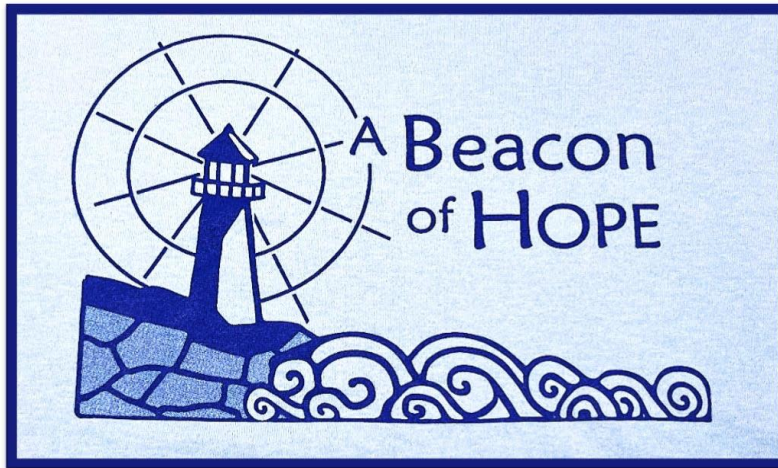
taught singing schools in Iowa, and by age 17 Gabriel himself was leading his own shape-note singing school choirs, which learned and performed hymn tunes like today's Gradual hymn, Detroit (upon which the postlude is also based). Enjoy!
