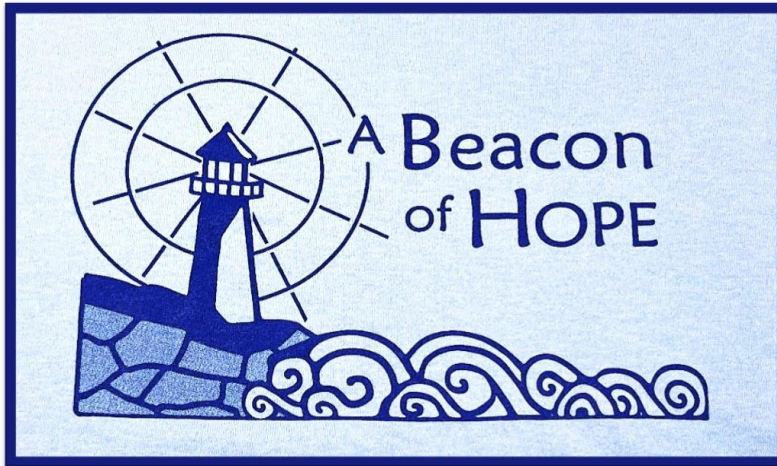


Healing Gardens
