(above photo), a member of the mint family that was planted earlier in the summer, has attracted many bumble bees as well as our first butterfly. Although the white cabbage butterfly is not a native, it is good news that it has found our gardens. Other plantings from last fall are in full bloom – both the swamp milkweed (pink) and the New England aster (purple).



We will be gathering Saturday, September 16th at 9 am to weed, plant new plants, and create a brick-lined path in the church yard. All are welcome and needed, as this is our opportunity to get everything in ship shape for the Diocesan Creation Care Conference at All Saints' on Saturday, September 23rd."

Music Notes

Our service on Sunday returns to musical settings of the *Gloria*, *Sanctus*, and *Agnus Dei*, rather than the spoken word, as was the case throughout the summer. For this Sunday and many services beyond this fall, we feature music of Robert J. Powell (b. 1932). Powell was born in Mississippi, did undergraduate work in Louisiana, and obtained a Master's degree at Union Theological Seminary in New York. There, he studied with Alec Wyton, whose music also appears in the hymnals and service music we use; and he served as Wyton's assistant at St. John the Divine. From 1965 to 1968, he worked as the Music Director and Organist at St. Paul's School in Concord, NH; and thereafter he moved to South Carolina, where until 2003 he served as Music Director at an Episcopal church in Greenville.

He has published widely for diverse instruments and ensembles (organ, choir, handbells, etc.), always with emphasis on accessibility and ecumenical usage.

Our anthem features a well-known gospel song by Doris Akers (1923-1995). Born in Missouri to biracial parents, she would write more than 500 songs in her lifetime, became known as "Miss Gospel Music" as a result, and was inducted into the Gospel Music Hall of Fame in 2001. Early in her career until 1965, she was well known for her work as director of the Sky Pilot Choir, an integrated chorus in Los Angeles. She was also a good friend of Mahalia Jackson. The inspiration for "Sweet,

sweet, spirit," as Akers herself once explained, was revealed during a prayer session with one of her choirs before a church service.
